



Checklist for Moving to .BANK Cybersecurity

1. Launch My .BANK - Get your .BANK Cybersecurity in place

Once your .BANK has the [Security Requirements](#) in place you can 'paste' your existing website to your .BANK and set-up a 301 redirect from there to your .BANK. This way any traffic to your old site (e.g., .COM) via bookmarks, favorites, links in old emails, search engines, etc. flow directly to your new .BANK domain. The 301 redirect also preserves your SEO ranking/reputation by carrying it forward to your .BANK domain.

- Set your optimum [timeline](#) for moving your website.
- For technical assistance with moving to .BANK cybersecurity, check with your Registrar and these approved [vendors](#).
- Check with your DNS provider to ensure they support **DNSSEC** and **vanity name servers**.
- For **TLS/Encryption**, confirm your hosting provider can meet the .BANK requirements [here](#) (e.g., TLS v1.2+ and secure cipher suites).
 - You need TLS certificates to secure your .BANK and these can be obtained from your existing trusted certificate provider, or your Registrar.
- For **DMARC and SPF**, your DNS is where these records are stored. Having SPF & DMARC (at "p=reject") ensures only your bank, and those you authorize, can send email *as* your bank, protecting against phishing and spoofing, and increasing the deliverability of email to your customers. See [email authentication vendors](#) that can help your bank.

2. Cores in .BANK

3. Promote my .BANK

On your .BANK add a cookie-based pop-up (or header banner) that welcomes everyone to your new, more secure, .BANK, and explains you made the move to .BANK to provide them an even more secure banking experience.
